

Notification – Southwest Metro

Campsie - October 2021

Sydney Metro is Australia’s biggest public transport project.

Services started in May 2019 in the city’s North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. There will be new CBD metro railway stations underground at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and new metro platforms at Central.

In 2024, Sydney will have 31 metro railway stations and a 66 km standalone metro railway system – the biggest urban rail project in Australian history. There will be ultimate capacity for a metro train every two minutes in each direction under the Sydney city centre. The upgrade of the T3 Bankstown Line to metro standards between Sydenham and Bankstown received planning approval on 19 December 2018.

In October, work will continue along the corridor and at Campsie Station (weather and site conditions permitting). Access to the rail corridor will be via existing rail corridor/pedestrian access gates. **Day work will be undertaken Monday to Friday 7am-6pm and Saturday 8am-6pm.** All work activities are subject to relevant approvals and will be tailored to the evolving Covid-19 situation at the time. Campsie (along the rail corridor)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Various site investigations and surveys including but not limited to non-destructive digging, soil assessments, geotechnical investigations and surveys for drainage, utilities, and fencing • Site investigation along Loch St bridge including partial lane closure between Wilfred & Lilian Lane • Devegetation and tree clearing throughout the rail corridor where required • Installation of fencing, signalling equipment, cable service routes, galvanised steel troughing (GST) • Delivery of plant and material including preparatory activities for upcoming out-of-hours work • Modification and upgrade works to bridges along the rail alignment including Duke St footbridge • Installing high voltage cables on the city side of Campsie Station
Around Campsie Station	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Establishment of temporary hoarding and fencing for staged demolition work on station concourse • Ancillary work around the station precinct including installation of a new ancillary facility on Wilfred Avenue (this will result in temporary loss of parking) • Building refurbishment work on station platforms and concourse • Preparation to occupy additional construction areas for permanent work and storage.
Services building site at Lilian Lane opposite Dewar Street	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Survey work and site investigations, soil waste classifications and relocation of services and utilities. • Bulk and detailed earthwork, footings and drainage work; stormwater drainage works into Lillian St (which will impact traffic flow)
Substation site (Off Lilian Street)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Installation of conduits, drainage pipes and pits and cable supports, tree trimming and removal • Formwork Reinforcement and concrete pouring <p>From time to time we may finish work later than 6pm as we complete concrete pours</p>
Bulk power supply work, Lilian Lane and Lilian Street	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Establishing temporary traffic changes, temporary pedestrian diversion, removing street parking • Tree trimming and removal • Removal of hazardous material. Materials will be removed in a safe manner by a licensed contractor • Cutting road pavement, excavating a trench and removing spoil, installing conduits in the trench, backfilling the trench, conduit testing and restoring the road surface.

Out-of-hours work

Due to the nature of some activities and for the safety of workers, some work will occur outside standard construction hours when trains are not running. Some equipment will also be delivered outside standard construction hours in line with Transport for NSW requirements for the movement of oversized vehicles. Properties in proximity to scheduled works will be notified prior to works starting. More information about this work is provided below and over the page.

Equipment used for all the above work will include excavators, jack hammers, vacuum trucks, slashers, motorised saws, concrete trucks, sucker trucks, delivery vehicles, borehole drillers, rollers, generators, whacker packers, dump trucks, wood chippers, mulchers, grass cutters, telehandlers, drilling rigs, lifting machinery, elevated work platforms, bobcats, concrete pumps, cranes, cable pulling equipment, road sweeper, compactors, chainsaw, lighting towers, forklifts, water carts, vibrating plates, and hand and power tools.

Access to buildings and driveways will be maintained at all times. Some of this work may be noisy, however we will take every possible step to minimise noise such as switching off equipment when not in use and using non-tonal reversing beepers. **Where temporary footpath changes, car parking removal or lane closures are required for works, traffic control, pedestrian detours and signage will be in place to assist the community.**
